





2019 LLOYD CELLARS STA. RITA HILLS PINOT NOIR

History

Sourced from the Sta. Rita Hills near Santa Barbara, this is a rich and elegant Pinot Noir that serves as a wonderful complement to our Chardonnay. The coastal influence of this region highlights the fruit's natural acidity and provides for a sophisticated presentation from start to finish.

Winemaking

100% Pinot Noir sourced from La Viña and Rio Vista Vineyards in Sta. Rita Hills. Submerged cap fermented. Barrel-aged for 10 months in French oak. Bottle aged for 12 months prior to release.

Sensorv

Harvested at a lower brix level than previous vintages, this Pinot Noir still retains notes of brambly fruits, cherry cola, and spice. However, there is a more elegant finish to our 2019 than in previous vintages. These integrated flavors are backed by toasty oak providing exceptional depth, length, and texture.
